LEASH LAW

Westford has a bylaw that REQUIRES dogs to be on their own property or on a leash at all times.

Dogs off their property will be picked up and taken to the pound by the Animal Control Officer.

DOG LICENSING

Dogs aged six months and older are required by State Law to be vaccinated against rabies and to be licensed by the Town. Dogs need to be re-licensed in January of each year. Dogs that are not licensed by the end of the grace period (March 31 of each year) are subject to a late fee of \$25. In April of each year the Animal Control Officer receives a list of dogs that have not been re-licensed or have received a rabies vaccination and have never been licensed.

Owners of more than four dogs ages three months or older are required to obtain a kennel license following inspection of the kennel by the Town's Animal Control Officer. (M.G.L. ch. 140 §137A)

If you are new to town, please license your dog as soon as possible to avoid a late fee.

DOG LICENSING FEES ARE:

Non-altered dogs: \$20.00 license fee ~ Spayed / Neutered dogs: the \$15.00 licensing fee remains the same

If you are 70 years of age or older, the license fee for your dog is waived, but you still need to get your dog(s) licensed (late fee still applies)

To renew or apply by mail:

- Complete the renewal/application form.
- Include a check or money order, payable to the Town of Westford for \$15.00 (spayed/neutered) or \$20.00 per dog.
- Include a copy of your dog's rabies vaccination certificate (this will not be returned to you unless you request that we do so).
- Include a copy of your dog's spay or neuter certificate if it's not indicated on the rabies certificate.
- Include a self-addressed, stamped envelope (SASE) and add 20 cents to the regular postage price. If you don't include a SASE, we anticipate that you will be coming in to pick up your dog's license and tag at the Town Clerk's Office.
- Mail to: Town Clerk, Dog Licensing, 55 Main Street, Westford, MA 01886.
- If you're renewing the license, we may already have your dog's rabies certificate on file. Call us at 978-692-5515 if you're not sure. The rabies clinic is usually held in March at the Center Fire Station.

You may also renew/apply for your dog's license online or in person at our office. Please note that \$1 is added to the online dog licensing fee. This pays for mailing the license(s) and tag(s).

Legal references: M.G.L. ch. 140 §137 - 174E; Town General Bylaw Ch. 84.

Signs of Rabies - Unexplained aggression, impaired locomotion, varying degrees of paralysis, extreme depression or viciousness. The signs of rabies vary in animals. Some will display attack-like behavior while others appear sick or dazed.

Dog licensing fees changed in 2013 due to New Animal Control Legislation (section 11).

A rabies clinic is available to all Westford licensed dogs annually and is usually held in March.

CodeRED Notification System

A child is missing, a hurricane or tornado is approaching, a break-in occurs or a general message is needed to be sent to the community. Quick and accurate communication between law enforcement officials and community alliances is now available through CodeRED



What is the CodeRED Notification System?

CodeRED is a Community Messaging System, used to notify residences of emergency, non-emergency and general information through an automated telephone dialing system, which sends a message automatically to thousands of targeted residences and/or contact data bases.

How will the community benefit from use of CodeRED?

When important information needs to be communicated, CodeRED will allow the affected members of the community to be notified in a fraction of the time it would take town officials to manually convey these messages.

How can I take advantage of the CodeRED Notification System?

Most residents will not need to take action in order to receive notification of events on their home telephone.


However, if you have recently moved into Westford, changed your home phone number, or have an unlisted phone number you will need to register your phone number. If you had previously registered in the CityWatch system you do not need to register again in CodeRED.

In addition to your home phone number you can register any number of additional numbers, two at a time. These can be cell phone or work numbers. The numbers do not need to be located in Westford as long as the address you register them against is. In other words, you can register a phone number in Boston against your home address in Westford.

You can also register to receive notification via e-mail and sms.

ELECTRONICS COLLECTION

LEAF COLLECTION

The town does a leaf collection in November and December. You need to call the Town Clerks Office to have your address added to the list. The leaves must be placed in leaf paper bags. The fee is \$1.25/bag with a minimum of \$20.00. Check made payable to Acme and attached to one of the leaf bags.





TRASH/RECYCLING

Every week, your household trash will be picked up at the curb. There is no additional fee for the general trash that goes in your trash barrels (up to three - 32 gal. capacity barrels). That is covered by your property tax. A maximum of 3 trash bags/barrels per week.

A \$5.00 bulk sticker will need to be purchased for items that don't fit into the trash barrel: mattresses, furniture, etc. (see White Goods information on page 21 for **non burnable** items) More information is included in the Westford Recycling Guide, available at the Town Clerk's office and on the Recycling Commission's website at www.westfordma.gov. **The bulk stickers may be purchased at the Town Clerks Office, Tedeschi's, Nab One Stop, Ace Hardware and Market Basket.**

- All trash must be at curbside by 7a.m. Please do not block mailboxes.
- Trash barrels or bags may not weigh more than 50lbs

Not Recycling?

Then your household trash **WILL NOT** be collected. Westford has had **MANDATORY RECYCLING** for residents for almost twenty years.

Why? Two reasons:

1. The Department of Environmental Protection bans glass bottles, cans, plastic containers and paper from incinerators and landfills. Our trash goes to an incinerator, and the Town of Westford can be fined heavily if there are recyclables in a load of trash.
2. Westford pays \$69 per ton of trash taken to the incinerator. Residents who don't recycle are costing taxpayers an unnecessary extra \$69,000 for every 1000 tons of recyclables tossed in the trash."

RECYCLING IS EASY!

There is no sorting needed. Glass jars & bottles, plastic containers & jugs, cans, and all paper can go into the same container. Use a bin, a wheeled recycling toter, or any barrel with a RECYCLE sticker on it. Stickers are free. (See below.) Trash goes into a separate barrel.

Remember if there are recyclables in your trash and/or there is no recycling container out on your recycling day, the trash hauler will leave your trash behind. **Leave your recycling bins/toters at the curb until your trash has been picked up to avoid this happening.**

If you choose not to recycle, you can hire any trash hauler to take away your trash. Look under Garbage Removal in the Yellow Pages or look online.

Or, you can start recycling. It's your choice....

WESTFORD RECYCLING ENFORCEMENT POLICY FAQ

Do I have to put out a recycling container on the trash only week to have my trash collected? No, however, if it is obvious to the casual observer that there are recyclables in the trash, it will not be collected. The only change recyclers need to make is to keep their recycling bins out until the trash collection is completed on recycling week.

Are we eliminating a week of trash removal (going to every other week for trash)/adding a week of recycling removal (having weekly collection of recyclables)? No, the current collection schedule is unchanged.

Is someone inspecting my trash? What if I include a single item of recycling in my trash by mistake? No one is going through your trash. Decisions will be made based on what is obvious to the haulers and your neighbors: does the distribution of the volume of your waste stream reflect a reasonable effort to recycle and are there visible signs of recycling in your trash? If not, you need not be concerned, however, please feel free to reference the recycling guide, on the WRC website, Facebook or contact the Recycling Commission via email or by phone. We would be happy to help you with any questions you may have regarding what to recycle and what to throw away. Most households have far more recycling than trash.

I find it too difficult/dangerous to get to the curb in the winter/rain so I stockpile my recycling for good weather days, when it is less dangerous to me, the paper is less heavy for the hauler, and the wind doesn't blow recyclables. This is a container issue, not a recycling issue. Westford is lucky to have a very flexible system regarding recycling containers. Unlike many towns, residents of Westford are not mandated to have a specific container for recycling. Simply acquire a container that fits your needs, get a free sticker from the Town Clerk, and place the labeled container on the opposite side of your driveway from your trash. If you are concerned about wind or precipitation, or like to set recycling out the night before collection, it would be best to have a container with a lid. The container should be sized appropriately for your household so you can move it, store it, and not over stuff it. If you can get your trash to the curb in the container of your choosing, you should be able to get recycling to the curb in a container that meets your needs.

Why can't I get a free toter? IPR initially provided free toters to Westford residents until they realized that the cost of providing toters to everyone in town would be prohibitive. These 64 gallon toters with yellow lids belong to IPR, not the homeowner, and are linked to the address they were delivered to. The Town of Westford did not pay for the toters.

How can I get a toter? The Recycling Commission purchases 64 gallon toters with green lids and sells them at cost to residents. These toters belong to the homeowner, just as their trash cans do. If you would like to order one, simply send or deliver a check for \$50 payable to the Recycling Commission to the Town Clerk, and a Commission volunteer will contact you to arrange for pick up. Homeowners can also buy toters or receptacles of their choosing from any hardware store.

What about my shared driveway/Condo? How do they know if it was me who skipped recycling or my neighbor? The enforcement is not that finely correlated. As long as there is recycling out at a given pick up location and no obvious recyclables in the trash, the trash will be collected

If I am away, then I won't have recycling. And you won't have trash. It is more likely, given every other week collection of recyclables, you will have recyclables and not trash, and in that case, the recyclables will be picked up.






