

# Request a FREE Safe Footing Kit... while they last!

The Town of Westford cares *deeply* about the safety of its residents! Therefore, several local entities are collaborating to protect our most vulnerable citizens against the risk of falling on slick walkways this season. We are pleased to offer 'Safe Winter Footing Kits' upon request.



Each kit comes with:

- An 8-pound bin of pet-friendly ice melt
- A flyer with local resources and *Tips to Avoid Slips*
- A 22" scraper with brush
- A seasonal ornament

An early recipient told us that she loved it, and that the size of the ice melt dispenser really helps with her disability.

Eligible recipients must be Westford residents aged 55 and older, who would be clearing their *own* porch and walkways from ice and snow, and have some type of disability (which you needn't identify).
