Pedestrian Safety Committee

Project Need

- Pedestrian Safety & Accessibility
 - Limited sight distance at crosswalks
 - Missing or ADA/AAB non-compliant pedestrian curb ramps
 - High demand / low visibility crosswalk at Parish entry
- Vehicular Safety
 - Limited sight distance due to:
 - Intersection skew
 - Stop line set back
 - High turning speed due to large corner radius at NE intersection corner

Existing Conditions



Project Goals

- Improve Pedestrian Safety & Accessibility
 - Increase sight distance & minimize crossing distance
 - Construct ADA/AAB compliant pedestrian curb ramps
 - Apply high visibility crosswalk markings
 - Install rapid flashing beacons & warning signs
- Enhance Vehicular Safety
 - Increase sight distances by T-ing up West St
 - Reduce turning speeds by removing excess pavement

Proposed Improvements



Project Impacts

- Parking
 - Loss of 2 spaces in upper Parish lot
- Grading
 - Full depth pavement to level out revised intersection
- Utilities
 - Relocation of utility pole on northwest corner of intersection
- Right of Way
 - 2 Permanent Layout Alterations
 - Sidewalk on West Street
 - Rapid Flashing Beacon & Pedestrian Curb Ramp on Parish property
 - 2 Temporary Easements
 - Driveway, parking lot, & walkway reconstruction
 - Grading
