- **Solar Installation**
 - **SMART 3.0 program and net metering for your residential solar system:**
 - Owners will receive monthly direct payments from the SMART program for the energy their system generates, By combining net metering and SMART, owners can significantly reduce the overall cost and improve the long-term return on investment of their solar system. [Find Out More and Apply Here](#)
 - SMART 3.0 provides enhanced offerings for community solar projects, including a minimum bill discount for low-income customers. [Learn more about benefits of community solar.](#)
 - **Massachusetts Residential Renewable Energy Income Tax Credit** which is 15% of the net system cost, up to a maximum of \$1000
 - **Solar Sales Tax Exemption:** You are exempt from paying the 6.25% sales tax on qualifying solar energy equipment and installation labor for your primary residence.
 - **Solar Installation Property Tax Exemption:** Installing solar panels will not increase your property taxes for that installation
