- ✓ Solvent Adhesives

- ✓ Gasoline/Kerosene/Mixed Fuels
- ✓ Antifreeze
- ✓ Engine Degreaser
- ✓ Brake Fluid/Carburetor Cleaner
- ✓ Transmission Fluid
- ✓ Car Wax, Polishes
- ✓ Driveway Sealer
- ✓ Roofing Tar
- ✓ Lead Acid (Car/Tractor) Batteries

From the Yard:

- ✓ Poisons, Insecticides, Fungicides
- ✓ Chemical Fertilizers
- ✓ Weed Killers
- ✓ Swimming Pool Chemicals
- ✓ Moth Balls
- ✓ Flea Control Products

- ✓ Hand Sanitizer contaminated with methanol
- ✓ Rubber Cement, Airplane Glue
- ✓ Fiberglass Resins
- ✓ Photo Chemicals
- ✓ Chemistry Sets
- ✓ Furniture Polish
- ✓ Floor and Metal Polish
- ✓ Oven Cleaner
- ✓ Drain and Toilet Cleaner
- ✓ Spot Remover
- ✓ Rug and Upholstery Cleaner
- ✓ Hobby Supplies, Artist Supplies
- ✓ Fingernail Polish and Remover
- ✓ Flea Collars

How Can I Safely Transport These Hazardous Materials?

- Leave materials in original containers.
- Tighten caps and lids.
- Sort and pack separately: Oil paint, pesticides, and household cleaners.
- Pack containers in sturdy upright boxes and pad with newspaper.
- NEVER MIX CHEMICALS.
- Pack your car and drive directly to the site.
- NEVER SMOKE while handling hazardous materials.

What Not to Bring!!

- x **NO LATEX PAINT**
- x No Empty Containers/Trash
- x No Commercial or Industrial Waste
- x No Radioactive Waste
- x No Smoke Detectors
- x No Infectious & Biological Wastes
- x No Ammunition, Fireworks, or Explosives
- x No Fire Extinguishers
- x No Prescription Medicines or Syringes
- x No Computers or other Electronics
- x No Asbestos
- x No Pressurized Cylinders
- x No Fluorescent Light Tubes or CFL's*
- x No Lithium or NiCad Batteries*
- x No Propane Tanks or Propane Cylinders*
- x **No Motor Oil***

* Take fluorescent tubes/bulbs as well as Lithium and NiCad batteries to Westford Ace or MacKay Ace Hardware year-round (no charge)

* Take large propane tanks to Westford Ace or MacKay Ace Hardware year-round (fee); dispose of small, empty propane cylinders in the trash

* Take up to 5 gallons of motor oil (oil only, no mixed fuels) to Autozone in Chelmsford (no charge)
